

## **2019 Commuter Challenge Promotional Rules**

2019 Commuter Challenge is open to anyone 18 years or older who commutes to, from, or through San Mateo County using a commute alternative to driving alone, such as carpool, vanpool, Caltrain, BART, public bus, ferry, shuttle, bicycle, walk, or telework, during the months of April and May 2019.

Participants using alternative commute modes have a chance to win weekly prizes by logging commute alternative trips each week during the months of April and May 2019. All participants who log a commute alternative trip for a minimum of three weeks during April and May will also be entered into the grand prize drawing. Trips must be logged by June 9, 2019, 11:59pm PDT to be entered into the grand prize drawing.

Selected winners will be notified by the email address provided in the my.commute.org system. If a selected winner cannot be reached within five (5) business days after the date of the first contact attempt, or is disqualified for any reason, Commute.org may select an alternate winner at random from the remaining eligible entries. Each verified winner will be required to complete and submit an Affidavit of Eligibility, Publicity Release, and Liability Waiver form provided by Commute.org within five (5) business days of receipt in order to claim the prize. If a selected winner cannot be reached or fails to submit the completed version of the form listed above within the required time period, that selected winner forfeits the prize.

Email addresses provided by participants will be added to the Commute.org electronic newsletter distribution list and used to ask participants to complete a post-campaign online survey.
