VANPOOL PROGRAM FAQ

Q. What is a vanpool?

A vanpool is a group of five to 15 people commuting together with an unpaid driver

Q. Do I have to lease the van?

Yes, the lease must be with [Commute with Enterprise](#)

Q. How do I know if I'm eligible to participate in a subsidized vanpool?

Q. How much does the vanpool cost?

The monthly costs depend on the vehicle type and the distance you travel. Everyone in the vanpool splits the costs for rent and fuel.

Costs will be offset by JUHSD workforce housing grant, [MTC Bay Area Vanpool program](#) and the JUHSD pre-tax payroll deduction programs.

Q. How much are vanpools eligible for under the JUHSD grant?

\$600 per month, per van

Q. How much are vanpools eligible for under the MTC Bay Area Vanpool program?

\$400 per month, per van

Q. What is the JUHSD pre-tax payroll deduction program?

Similar to medical flex spending, you are eligible to set aside your split of the monthly vanpool fee pre-tax. This can be deducted directly from your paycheck and sent to Commute with Enterprise.

Q. What is included in the vanpool monthly cost?

- A recent-model van, SUV or crossover
- Insurance & physical damage protection
- Comprehensive maintenance program
- 24/7 roadside assistance

Q. How do I cancel my participation in the vanpool program?

You are required to contact your vanpool coordinator and provide 30 days' notice

Q. What other programs are available to vanpooling?
