VANPOOL ELIGIBILITY & PROGRAM RULES

ABOUT THE VANPOOL PROGRAM

- A vanpool is a group of five to 15 people commuting together with an unpaid driver
- This grant provides \$600 per month to qualifying vanpool groups who rent their vanpools from [Commute with Enterprise](#)
- Program funding provided by the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA)
- Program end date is June 30, 2024

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be staff or faculty of Jefferson Union High School District (JUHS) and reside at the district's 705 Serramonte workforce housing project in Daly City
- Vanpools must start at the district's 705 Serramonte workforce housing project in Daly City and end at a JUHS worksite
- Must complete monthly ridership reports and annual survey
- Must maintain 50% occupancy each month
- Applicants who participate in the JUHS Vanpool to Work program are not eligible for the Bicycle Purchase Rebate program for one year

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants can attend a vanpool meeting, complete an [interest form](#) or email us at support@commute.org to join or create a vanpool
- Once 5 or more commuters commit to riding together, Commute with Enterprise will assist with the vanpool formation, determine monthly fee and delivery of van
- The monthly fee will be reduced by the grant subsidy. The remaining amount will be split by the vanpool participants
- JUHS allows staff and faculty to set aside their own money pre-tax to pay for their split of the monthly vanpool fee. Contact your JUHS administrator for more details.
- Commute with Enterprise will require a coordinator and potential drivers to complete a separate agreement prior to van delivery
- Commute.org reserves the right to deny eligibility to any individual deemed, in Commute.org's sole discretion, to be violating the terms, conditions, and restrictions of the Program.
- Commute.org JUHS Vanpool grant subsidies are subject to funding availability. Vanpool subsidies will be issued on a first-come first-served basis until funding is depleted or until the program ends.
