Commute.org's Programs & Services

Commute.org provides free programs and services to San Mateo County employers and commuters to:

- Help people find and use cost-effective alternatives to driving alone
- Encourage and reward sustainable commuting
- Reduce traffic congestion and the stress of commuting
- Improve air quality
- Help employers comply with local and regional ordinances

Shuttles

We operate shuttles to BART and Caltrain stations in San Mateo County as well as the South San Francisco ferry terminal.

Employers, property managers, and developers can contact us to:

- Join an existing shuttle consortium
- Establish a new shuttle route
- Promote the shuttle program to employees and tenants

Commute Platform (STAR)

STAR (Support, Track, and Reward) is an online commute platform for commuters and employers.

Commuters can:

- Discover commute options
- Find carpool/vanpool/bikepool partners
- Log commute trips
- Access rewards and challenges

Employers can:

- Setup intra-company ride matching
- Load their own commute programs
- Track and monitor commute activity

Bike/Carpool/Vanpool Rewards

Commuters that bike, carpool, or vanpool can claim a \$25 gift card reward for every 10 commute days tracked on STAR (up to 4 rewards per year).

Commuter Store - Free Prizes

Commuters who log their sustainable commutes can earn points for prizes in the STAR Store.

Try Transit - Free Transit Tickets

Commuters who have not taken transit can try it for FREE. We partner with transit agencies such as Caltrain, SamTrans, and San Francisco Bay Ferry, to offer transit tickets.

Guaranteed Ride Home (GRH)

In the event of an emergency, commuters who use a sustainable commute to work/college can get reimbursed for their trip home. We cover up to 4 trips per year through STAR (up to \$60/trip).

Challenges and Pledges

Commuters and employers can earn prizes and be entered into raffle drawings by participating in local and regional challenges and pledges sponsored by Commute.org and its partners throughout the year.

TDM Symposium

An annual convening of employers, property managers, non-profits, government agencies, and TDM professionals to share best practices and learn about the resources that are available in San Mateo County.

Services

Personalized Commute Planning

Expert help for commuters looking to develop sustainable commutes to, from, or within San Mateo County.

Bicycle Safety Education

Virtual/on-site workshops that cover bike riding tips, laws, repair, and maintenance.
